## Summary Report

### Annual General Meeting of the Harvard Club of Bulgaria, 23 September 2002

In the American Center, Vitosha Blvd 18, 1000 Sofia official hosted and welcomed by the Deputy Director of the Center Mr. Keith Hughes on behalf of the Director, Mr. Michael Seidenstricker

1. According to the Agenda, Mr. George Veltchev opened the meeting, presenting the annual report and chaired a brief discussion on activities during the reporting period.
